1. General updates:

Helen gave a few updates on Good Food Lewisham activities over last three months:

- Foraging events for World Food Day LL ran a small grants programme to support groups to run activities around World Food Day and London Challenge Day. Nine projects were awarded £250 grants, 11 activities took place with over 200 people engaging. - Helen worked with Community Connections Lewisham to organise a Christmas provision list: Helen B: 'That was disseminated and used so widely - it was really worthwhile and valued'
- LL applied and was successful in getting a 10k grant from Sustain for developing food growing network as part of the good food movement in Lewisham to deliver a year of activities starting 1st Feb
